

Billet Wheel Adapters & Spacers

Important notes:

- 1) Additional lug nuts may be required for your application. Please check before installation.
- 2) Always use jack stands when removing wheels.
- 3) Check wheels and rotors/drums for any rivet heads, burrs, scale, rust or other obstruction that would prevent the adapter from seating properly.
- 4) Check vehicle studs and nuts to ensure they do not contact or interfere with the wheel after the adapter is bolted in place. The wheel must sit flush against the adapter.
- 5) Hand torque all lug nuts to factory specifications.
- 6) Check for wheel and tire clearance lock to lock and fender to tire clearance before driving.
- 7) Check and re-torque wheel nuts every 3,000 kms.

Torque specs:

 $12mm \times 1.5 = 87 \text{ ft/lbs}.$

 $14\text{mm} \times 1.5 = 139 \text{ ft/lbs.}$
